In order to give you the best possible chance to arrive in September as prepared as you can be, we want you to work through an online course: “Transition to A-Level Mathematics”. The course materials consist of video clips, activities and assignments on 7 key topic areas which are designed to prepare and support you through to the start of the A Level course.

You need to watch the introductory video and then follow the instructions to work through the 7 areas. There are 7 assessments that we expect you to complete, and the A-Level team here at Luffa will be monitoring how you’re doing throughout the Summer, and checking for levels of completion throughout. There are also optional “Going Deeper” materials and assessments should you wish to explore these.
