For your bridging work we want you to work through an online course:

“Transition To A Level Mathematics”. The course materials consist of video clips, activities and assignments on 7 key topic areas which are designed to prepare and support you through to the start of the A Level course. You need to watch the introductory video and then follow the instructions to work through the 7 areas. The work starts with a useful reminder of some key topics you will explore at A level, and then delves deeper into the concepts which will give you a flavour of what to expect in September.

There are **7 assessments** that we expect you to complete. There are also optional “Going Deeper” materials and assessments should you wish to explore these. Your teachers are able to access your results.

To access the course you have an individual login to the Integral platform (details below). You will be using this platform extensively in Maths A level, so getting used to it now is also a real advantage.
