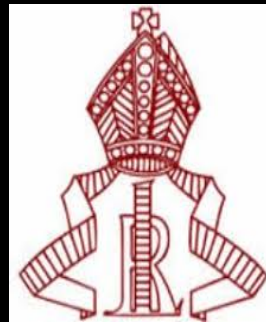

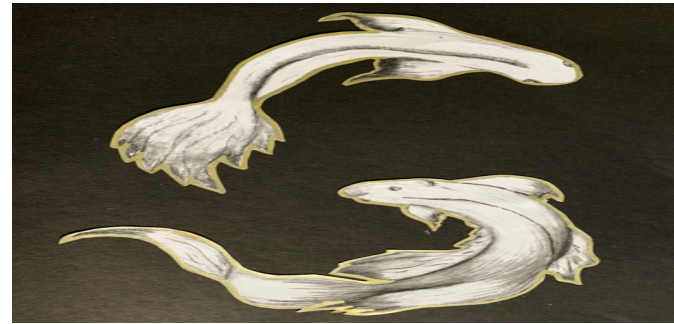

## Differences At Bishop Luffa School

- Early start 8am! (Bags packed previous night).  
2:30pm finish. Good breakfast + early night.
- Size: 1500+ pupils and 90+ staff  
Map + guided for 2wks. At least 10 teachers.
- Lockers - PE kit, coats, lunch. Key ring required.
- 2 Week Timetable (A+B). 4 lessons in morning  
/ 1 after Lunch. Issued in September
- School Planner - Homework (Google Classrooms),  
codes, notes, important diary dates
- New Communication Portal: Arbor



# Homework

- Recorded in the school "planner" and also on Arbor + Google Classroom.
- Year 7: 2 x 20mins homework per night
- Quiet place + desk
- Planner is signed by parents and tutors each week.
- Check for any problems. Add comments
- Contact through planner - sign weekly

## The First Term

- Sherborne pupils taught as a group ( 7F) for the majority of the timetable through Y7
- Equipment - be prepared! Organisation = key.
- Appropriate school bag. 2 strap rucksack? Pencil case, daily books and A4 ring binder (worksheets/ notes)
- Put pupil name on everything.
- Valuables. Mobile phone switched off 8am-2:30pm. No ipods/expensive gadgets. Confiscated.
- Lunch: Yr 7 Cafe 40mins across 2 sittings.
- Little need for money in school. Lunch money preloaded. Cashless catering.
- Year 11 House Committee and Y8 buddies aiding Year 7s 1st term.





## Transport

- Drop off/pick up = turning circle
- No one will have a bus pass on the first day. Drivers know this and will let them on.
- Cyclists – need to have passed their cycling proficiency test and have filled in a Google Form for cycle permit application.
- Pupils must wear a helmet
