



- New Communication Portal: <u>Arbor</u>







# Homework

- Year 7: 2 x 20mins homework per night
- Quiet place + desk
- Planner is signed by parents and tutors each week.

- Year 11 House Committee and 48 buddies aiding Year 7s 1st term.








# Transport


