
What is Grassroots?



Leg 2 Gatwick to Dar Es Salaam Via Istanbul






Leg 3

What are we going to be doing?












What is it going to be like?

Isn't it dangerous?







- Risks are assessed by us, the school, County and Grassroots before the trip is finally approved
- Risk assessment available if you want to see it!
- A comprehensive insurance policy from WSCC

Do I need to have any jabs or tablets?

- You will need anti-malarial tablets
- We DO NOT give you medical advice- you must get that from your doctor/health professional. There are lots of options for vaccinations etc.
- We will need consent to allow emergency medical care to be administered on the trip
- If there are vaccinations that are recommended that you will not allow your child to take, YOU MUST TELL US IMMEDIATELY, as without some, the student will not be able to come on the trip
- Foreign travel advice

How much will it cost?

- £2,100 (with a potential small reduction for campers)
- \$50 for a visa, plus any potential medical costs
- You won't need much spending money when you're there!

How do I apply/what is the time scale?

- Application form due November 7th
- Online interviews w/c November 17th
- Decisions made during w/c November 24th
- Deposit due around start of January (date tbc)
- Final payment deadline May 13th

Applicants must have a valid passport valid for 6 months after return date- 21th July 2026 (i.e. 21st Jan 2026) by March 2026 when we have to allocate names to seats
