



Year 11 German Curriculum Map

Overview	<p>In Year 11, students will continue their study of the units as prescribed by the AQA exam board. They will develop understanding of and expressing descriptions and opinions. Grammatical knowledge will be built upon reinforcement from KS4, alongside understanding and application of more complex structures and verb conjugation. Continual skill development will occur through the inclusion of the four key areas of listening, speaking, reading and writing. Students will make links between these areas to develop their understanding of how languages work. A range of skills within these key areas will be developed throughout each unit with repeated practice. Each assessment will focus on one or two exam skill elements; usually a productive skill with a receptive skill.
