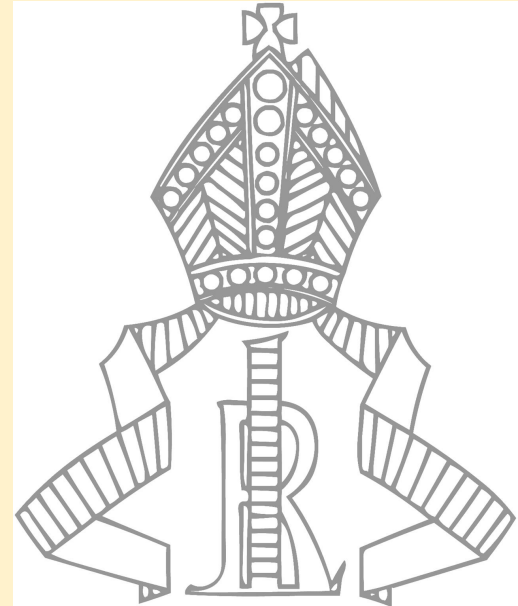
# What you could do to help your children learn

# What we will do to support their learning

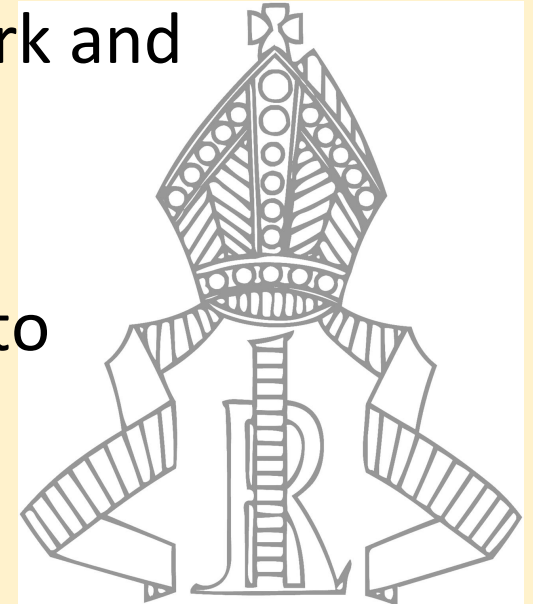
- Support the creation and use of action plans.
