

Overview	The A Level History course combines British and international history. Within Year 12 the focus is on 2 of the 4 required units. Students investigate Germany from 1918 to 1963, with a focus on the skill of extended writing. They also investigate the early Tudor monarchs, and the 'Mid-Tudor Crisis', with a focus on source analysis and evaluation, as well as extended writing. As well as completing past exam questions throughout the year, there are full mock exam papers for both units covered in Year 12, in the Summer Term. Students finish Year 12 by starting to investigate their Year 13 units (civil rights & the NEA). The Year 12 course develops a range of skills, such as use of key terms, understanding and use of second order concepts (e.g. cause and consequence), analysis and evaluation of source material, and coming to informed judgements. These skills have run throughout the key stages in History, but within the Sixth Form we look for sophisticated use of these skills, and an increasingly independent approach, encouraging students to stretch and challenge themselves, seeking to master the skills required in history.
