



Year 13 Economics Curriculum Map

Overview	<p>Within Year 13, the course asks students to consider Economics at the micro and macro scale. Theme 3 asks students to reflect on business behaviour and the labour market - how do businesses operate, and what are their aims, and what about the workers? Theme 4 considers the sensitive issue of globalisation and asks students to consider the causes and impact of globalisation. Students develop skills of analysis and evaluation across both themes. They develop data handling skills, as well as the ability to produce extended writing within Economics. Within the final part of the course they will revisit all 4 themes, and consider how to produce work focused on both micro and macroeconomic issues.</p>
