Overview	During Year 8 we concentrate on building key language skills using engaging content about the German-speaking world. Lessons focus on development of the four different skills required for learning German (Listening, Reading, Speaking and Writing) and help plan for and prepare students for GCSE. Students learn about vocabulary, grammar and culture through the medium of a variety of different topics. Lessons are differentiated to cater to all abilities ensuring that every student can progress. Cultural topics provide insight into life and traditions in German speaking countries. A step by step approach to grammar throughout the course ensures logical learning. The course builds a strong foundation for early learners of German with clear progression towards GCSE.
