

Year 13 Dance Curriculum Map

Overview	In the second year A Level Dance students will initially focus on preparations for their practical exam creating, learning, rehearsing and refining their two performance pieces: solo and quartet. They will either be taught by a professional dance artist when completing the performance as a quartet or collaborate to create the piece with your teachers. The exam board will release the choreography exam paper early in the autumn term so this will also become an important part of learning. At the same time students will study their second set work 'Sutra' and examine the area of study: Britain's Independent Contemporary Dance Scene 2000 to date. Students' practical exam will take place in the spring term with a visit from an external examiner. They will continue to consolidate and revise both set works and areas of study in preparation for their final written exam in the summer term.
