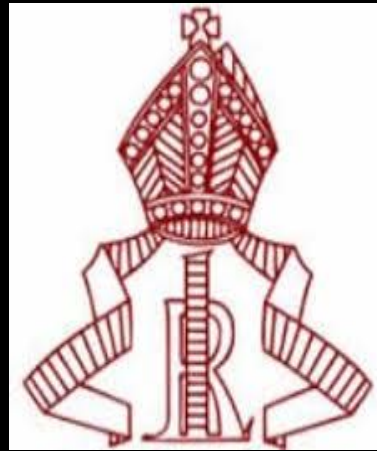

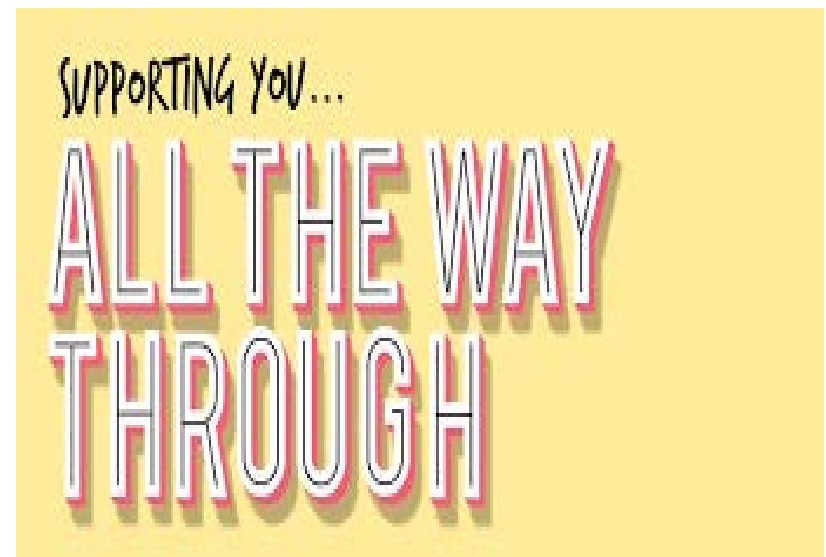

The First Term

- Sherborne pupils taught as a group (~~7E~~) for the majority of the timetable through Y7
- Equipment - be prepared! Organisation = key.
- Appropriate school bag. 2 strap rucksack. Pencil case, daily books and A4 ring binder (worksheets/notes)
- PE Kit on PE Days
- Put pupil name on everything.
- Valuables. **Don't bring Smart Phones to school**
- No social media accounts (WhatsApp 13yrs).
- No ipods/expensive gadgets. Confiscated.
- Lunch: Yr 7 40mins House rota.
- Little need for money in school. Lunch money preloaded. Cashless catering.

Transport
