Let's go ask.

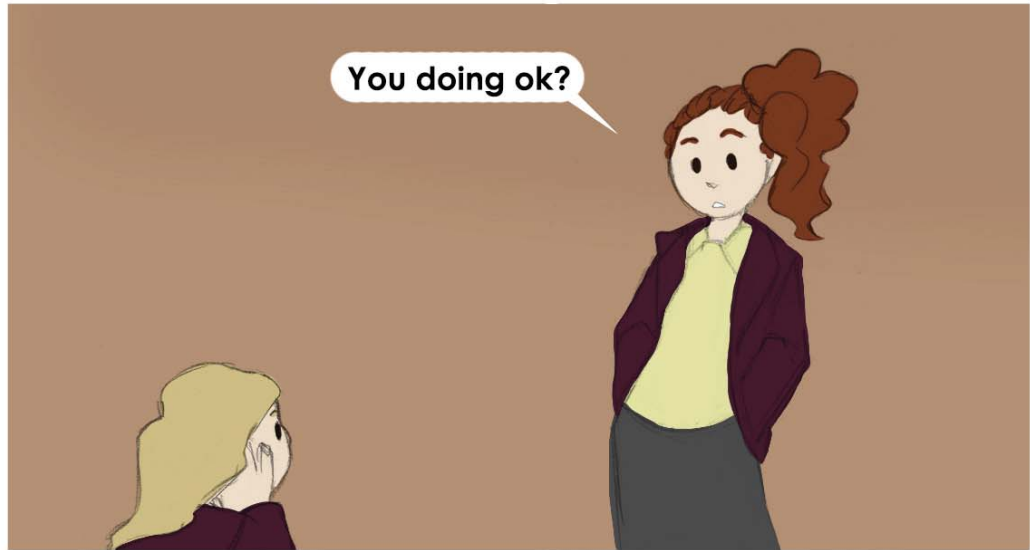

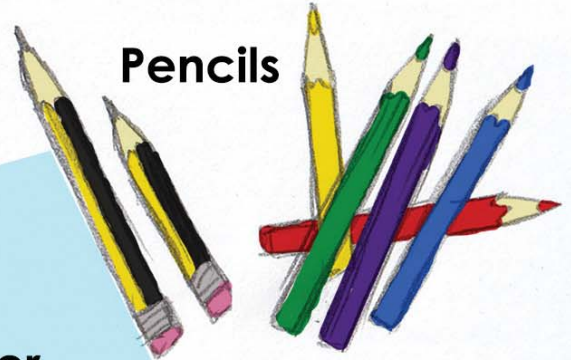
At Luffa you will need to bring your own equipment with you every day and have it in the bag that you take to lessons. Here are some reminders of what you will need.
