Like, all my books. I can't leave them in my locker all week if I need them for homework.



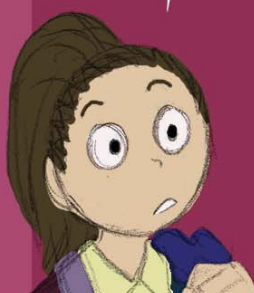
