Dear Parents and Carers,

Transition Tuesdays 2025 – Week 4

We are now just over a week away from welcoming you and your child to the school. Our staff and students always look forward to the transition events, and have been busy finalising the arrangements, and carefully planning activities to welcome and reassure your child. I have included some details below.

Parents' and Carers' Information Evening - Monday 30th June

This is for parents and carers only, and will begin at 6:30pm in the Bartlett Hall. You will find out more about the school, opportunities for your child, and how we will work together to support them. Our uniform supplier, Game, Set and Match will also be there. The PFA Secondhand Uniform Shop will be open from 5.30pm in the Bartlett Hall prior to the meeting.

Work on House allocation is nearing completion and we will be able to let you know which House you will be in, (we consider the parents and carers as part of the House too!), via email before Monday. You will meet your child's Head of House and Form Tutor, and hear more from them about the House, and why you are now, (in their opinion), in the best House in the school! There will be an opportunity to ask questions, and we would expect the evening to conclude by 8pm.

Our Site Team will be ready to welcome you, and assist with parking. Not valet style, but they will guide you to make use of our field as it will be a busy evening with a number of vehicles expected on site.

It is important that you attend this meeting, even if you already have another child in the school. If it is not possible for you to come, please inform the school beforehand, using the transition@bishopluffa.org.uk email address.

Year 6 Visit Day – Wednesday 2nd July

We hope your child is looking forward to taking their first step towards officially becoming a Luffa student. Their day begins at **9am**, and they will be met by a team of friendly 6th Form students and House Buddies, ready to reassure and guide them to the Bartlett Hall for an assembly. They will spend most of their day with their new Tutor Group, Head of House and Form Tutor, and finish off with a sample lesson in the afternoon. Their day ends slightly earlier than normal, at **2:15pm**. This will ease congestion on the school site, and we will provide more strategic information about managing (and avoiding!) this on Monday evening. Your child can bring a packed lunch or they can purchase lunch from the canteen - this will be

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

More 'hunts' will be added, and, as promised, the scores will be added to our Year 6 House Competition on Monday, once they are officially in Houses!
