We can't wait to welcome your child, and the rest of the Year 6 students, for their Year 6 Induction Day tomorrow! Please note the following key points to prevent traffic jam(s)!

- Please do not drop off your child before 9am
- If you are driving, please drop at the front of school (by the Sports Hall) and follow directions from site staff
- The back gate will also be staffed if you are walking in from the Bishop Luffa Close direction
- Pick up is at 2.15pm please don't arrive before 1.45pm if you are driving
- Our Site Team will be directing traffic at the beginning and end of the day please be kind to them

The students will start the day with an assembly led by Mr Hindman where they will be sat with their House. They will then spend time getting to know each other and their Form Tutor and Head of House. We will be taking a group photo and there will be a tour of the school with our Year 12 students.

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A canteen lunch is available if your child would like one - £3 for pizza, wedges, salad and a drink. Lunchtime is staggered with each House having a turn to eat together in the Bartlett Hall. This will be before the rest of the school has lunch. Please send your child with the correct money (£3) and this will be collected by their Head of House or Form Tutor in the morning. After lunch, your child will be taken with the rest of their tutor group for a sample lesson. The day will give your child a flavour of life at Bishop Luffa and the opportunity to make friends.
